

## **2018-2019 Standards for Participation and Graduation Recognition Requirements**

### **STANDARDS FOR PARTICIPATION**

The following standards are required to maintain an “active” participation status by students enrolled in the program:

- Yearly course loads must contain Dual Language and rigor courses (Pre-AP, AP, and or Credit).
- Maintain a passing grade in all classes
- Maintain an 85% overall average
- Pass applicable End-of-Course exam(s) for the current school year (EOC)
- Comply with EPISD’s Code of Conduct: <http://www.episd.org/Page/389>
- Earn 3-6 Spanish Credits based on your Spanish progression (see below)

### **PROBATION**

A magnet student’s “Active” status is verified at the end of every grading period. If a student is found in violation of one or more program standards, he/she is placed on academic “probation” for a period of 9 weeks. The magnet student will be made “inactive” during the probation period and will not be allowed to participate in any supplemental dual language enrichment activities that may occur during said probationary period. The student will have that 9 weeks to fall back into compliance. If after 9 weeks all requirements have been met, the student will be made active again. If not, the process to exit the student from the magnet program may begin.

### **SPANISH PROGRESSION**

Magnet students will follow an “Intermediate” or “Advanced” Spanish progression based on the student’s Spanish Assessment and/or Spanish course history:

## GRADUATION RECOGNITION REQUIREMENTS

Senior Dual Language Magnet students will be recognized at the time of graduation for their dual language coursework accomplishments:

\* When a scheduling conflict occurs that makes it impossible for a student to enroll in a dual language course, a waiver may be granted. The waiver must stipulate the circumstances and if approved, will not count against a dual language student with regard to attaining the aforementioned graduation recognition. Waivers will be reviewed and adjudicated upon by a committee consisting of dual language teachers, coordinator and El Paso HS administration.
